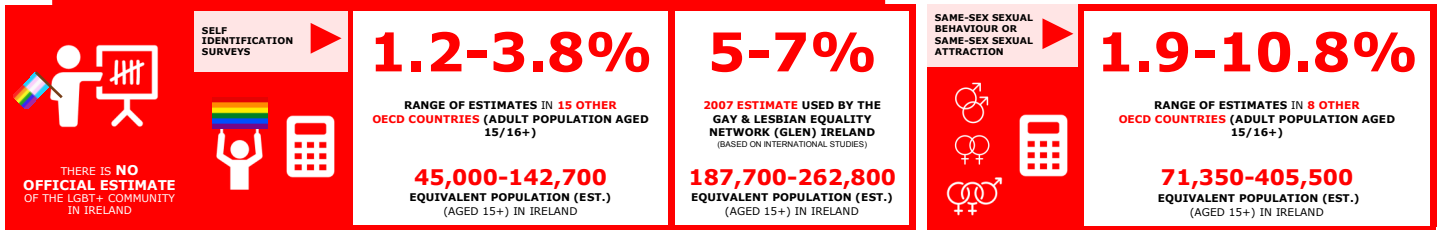

SIZE OF THE LGBT+ POPULATION

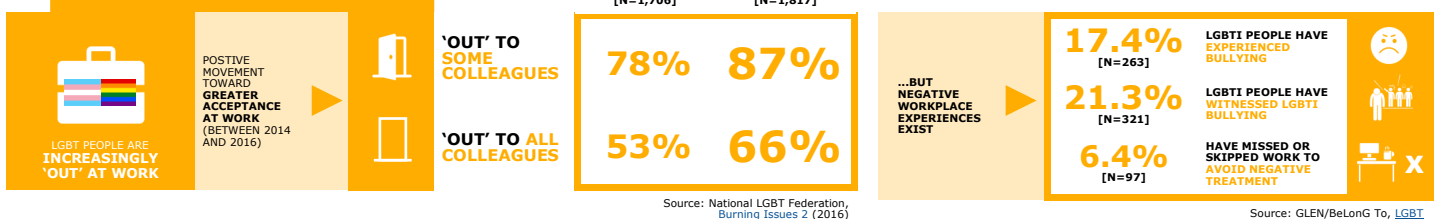

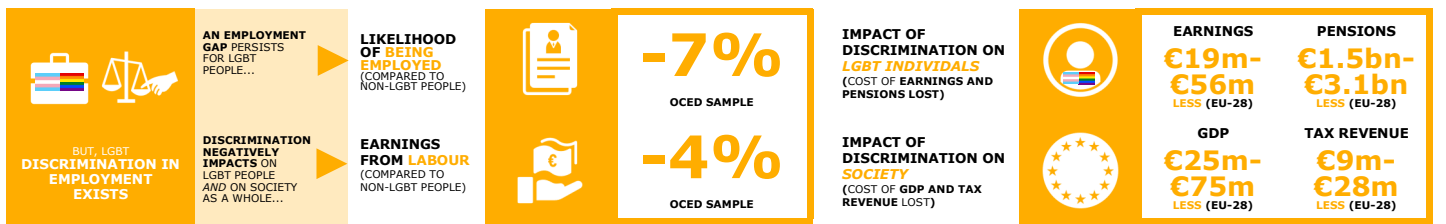

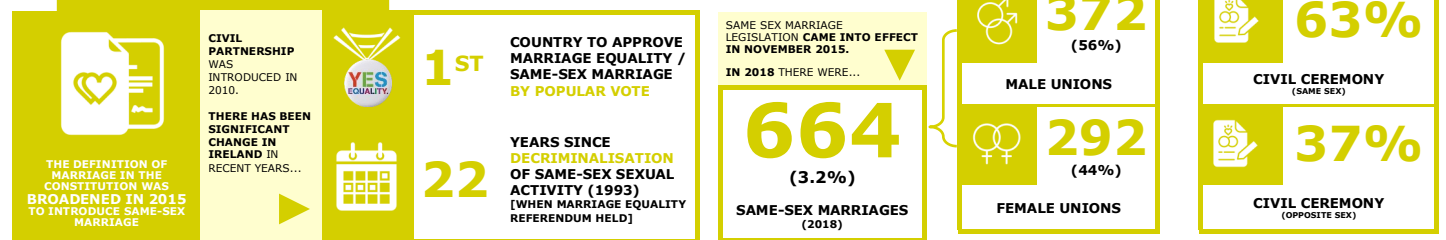

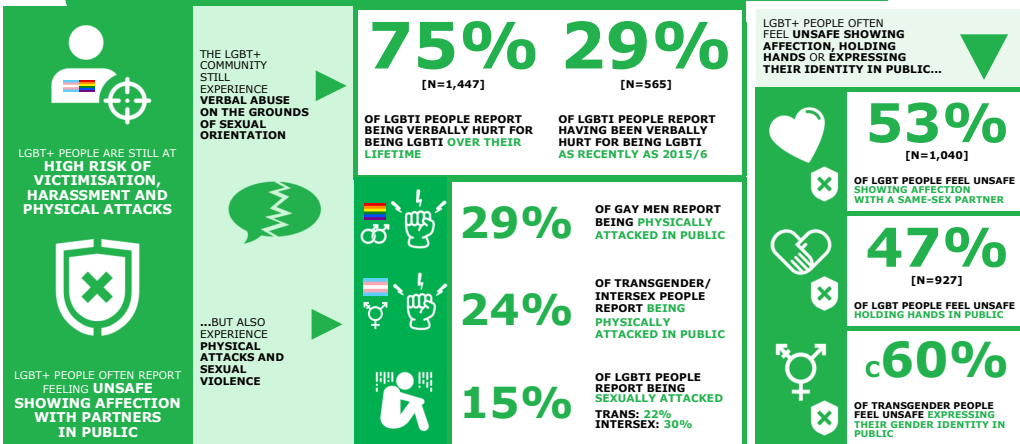

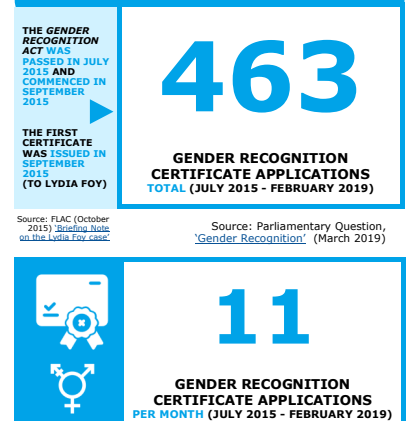

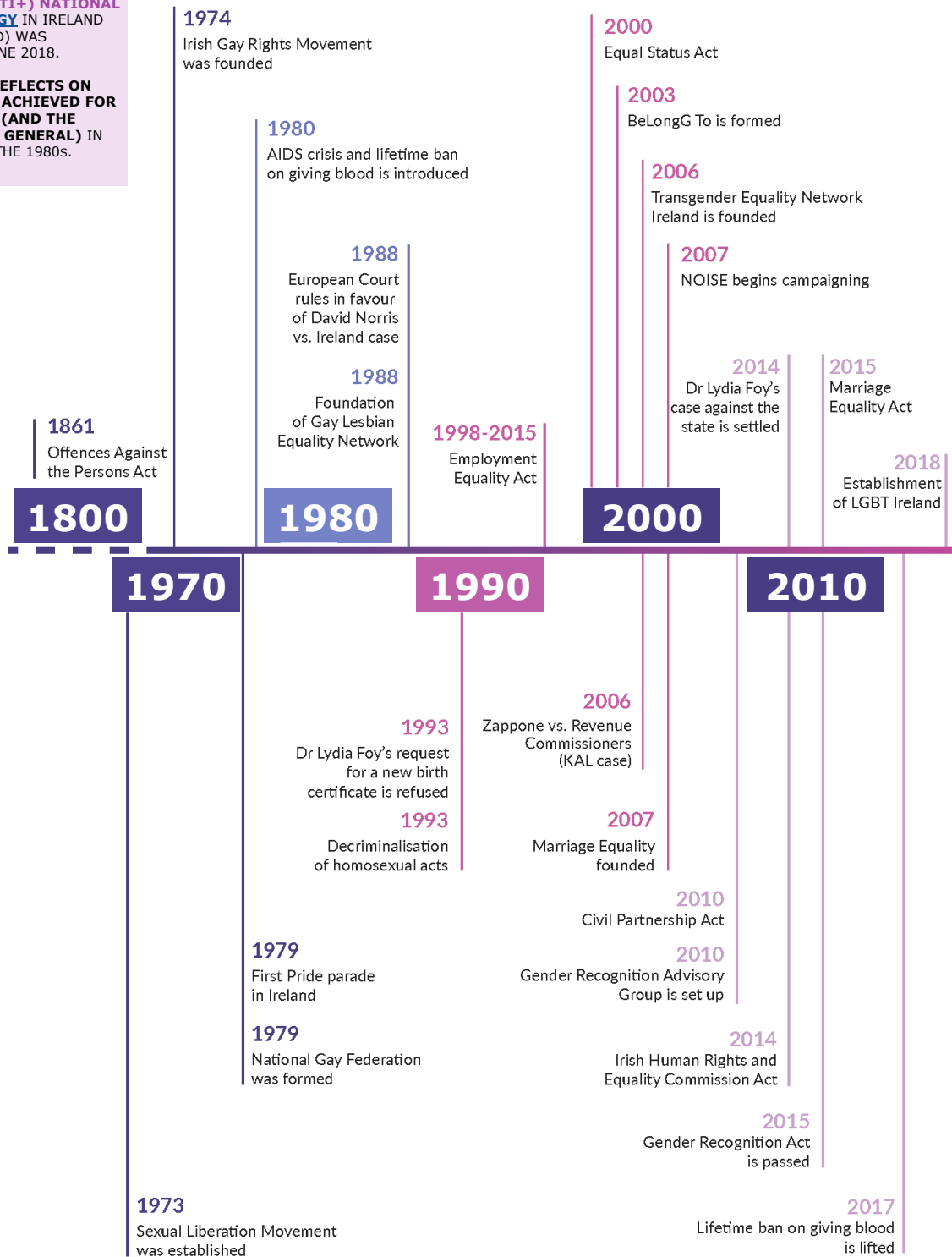
